



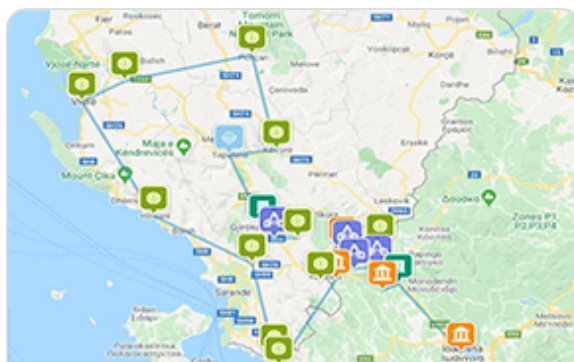

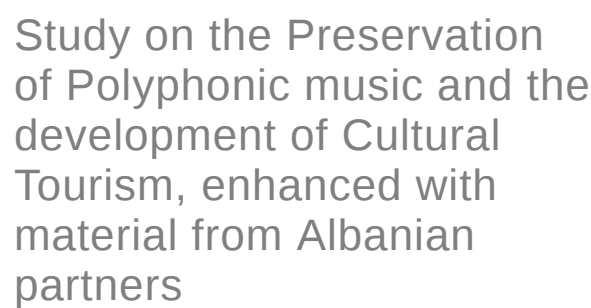

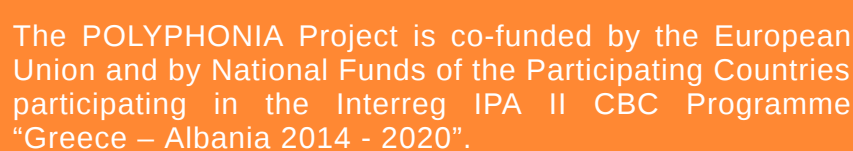
POLYPHONIA Thematic
